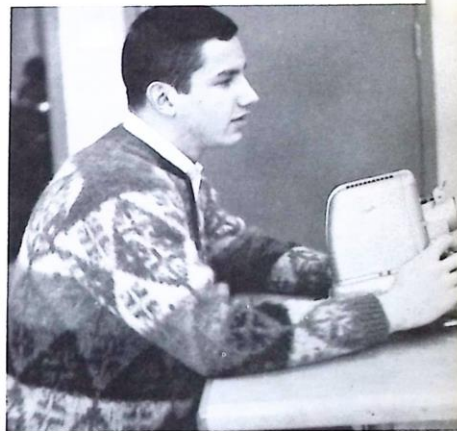

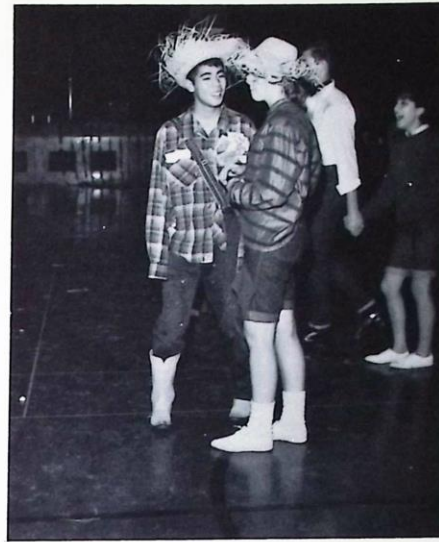

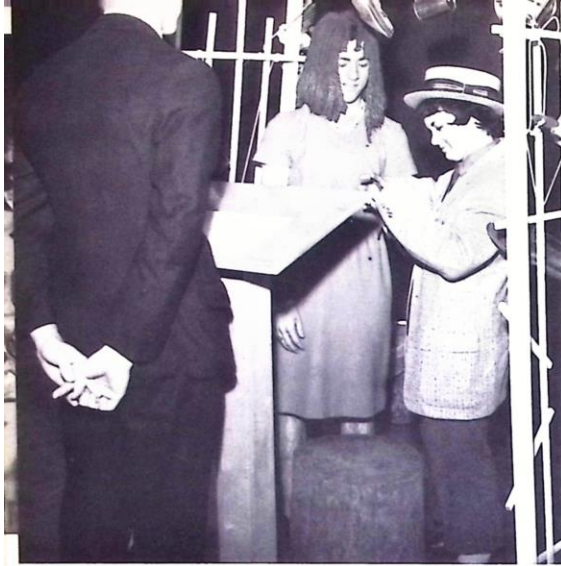

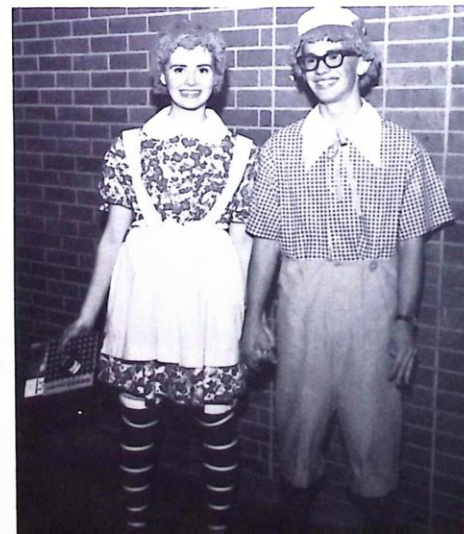


Sadie Hawkins Dance A Huge Success

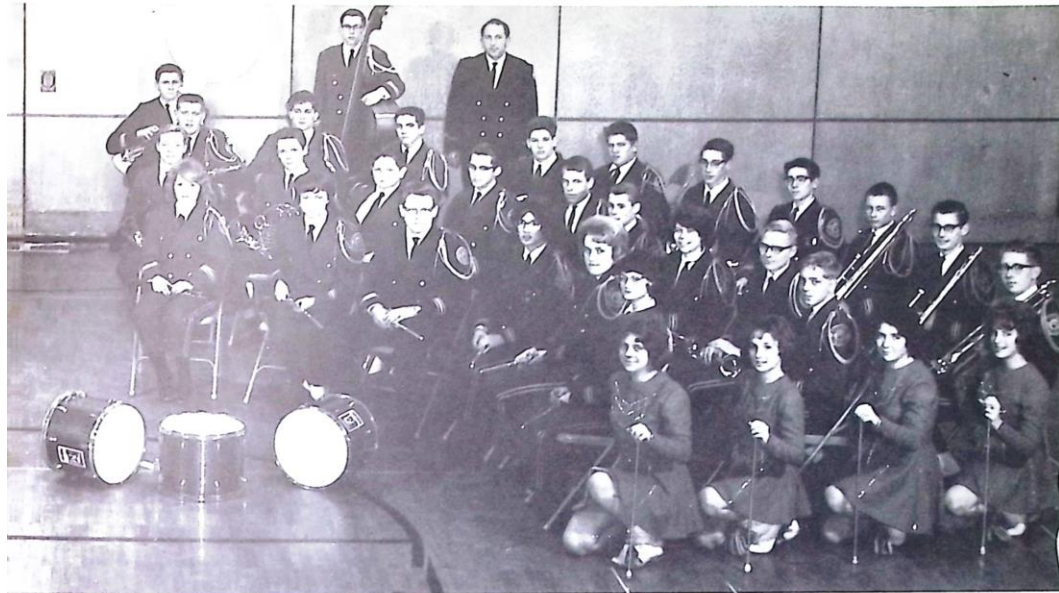

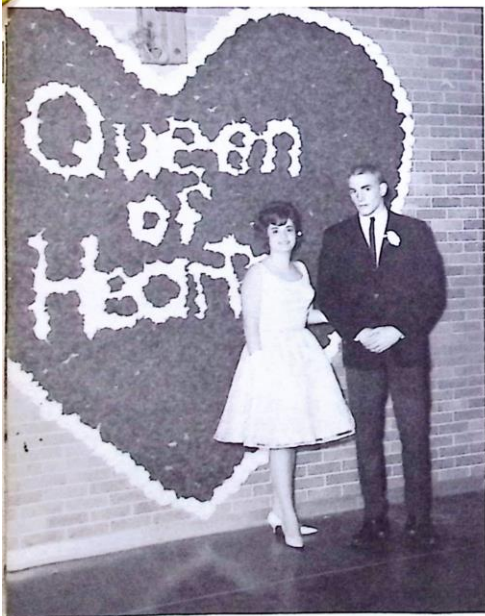

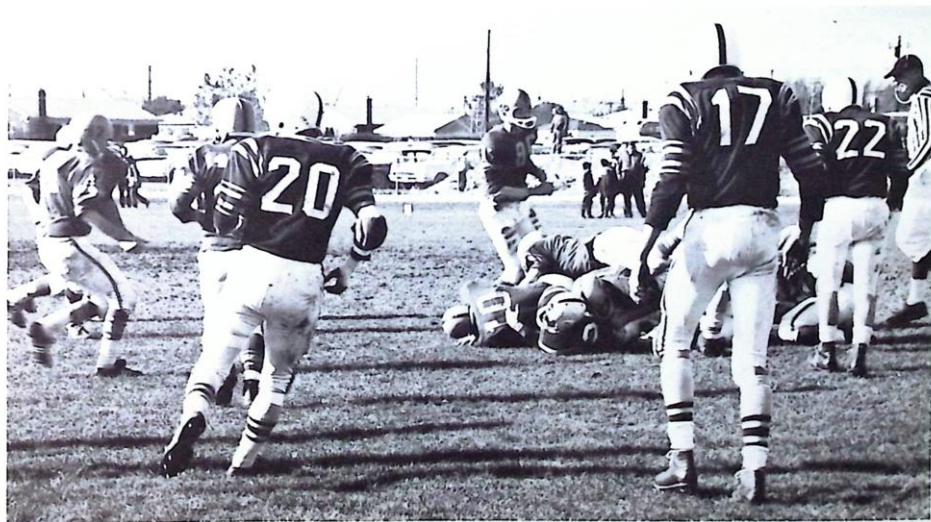
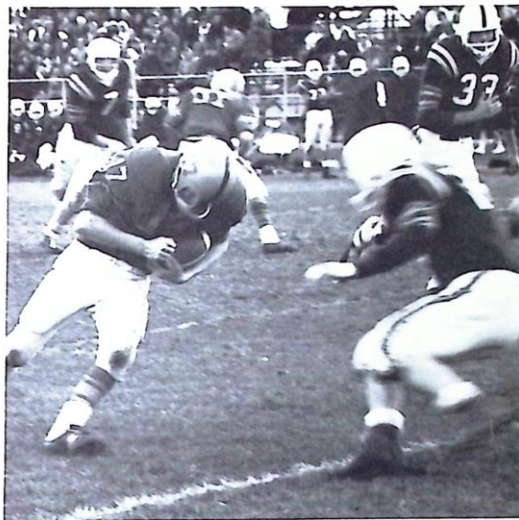

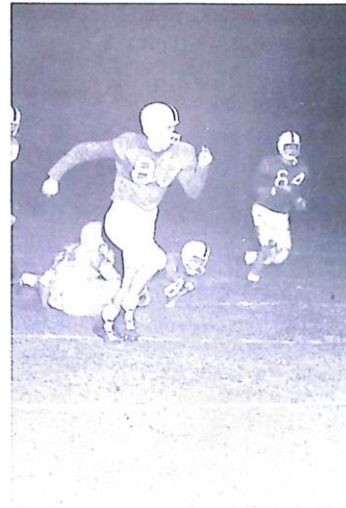

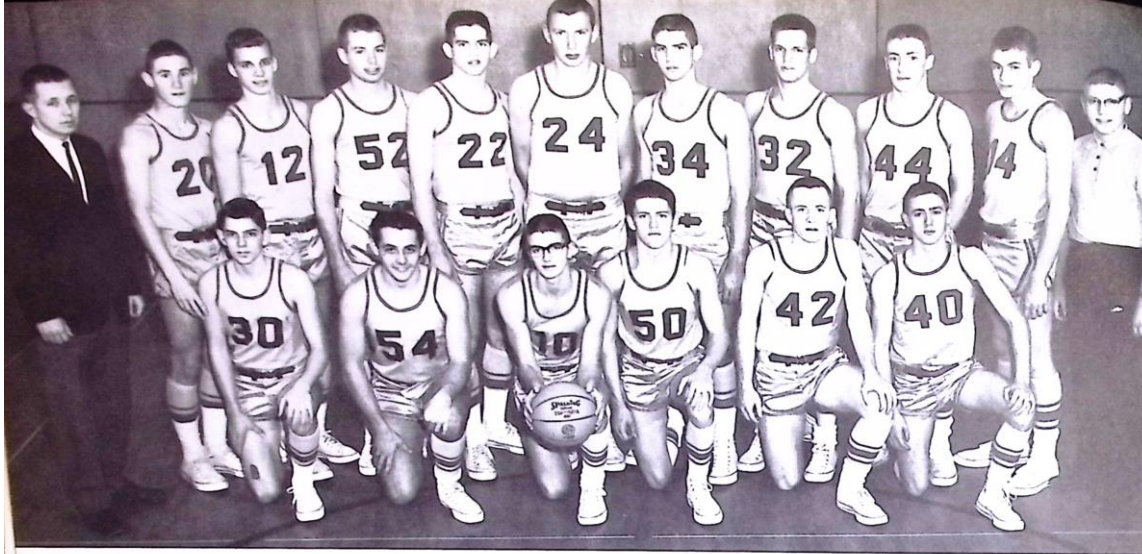

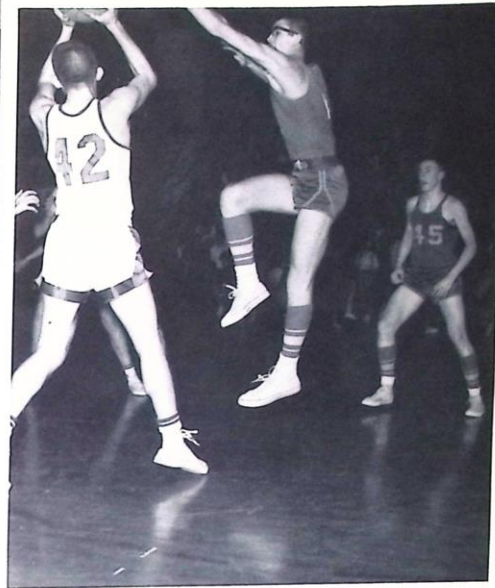

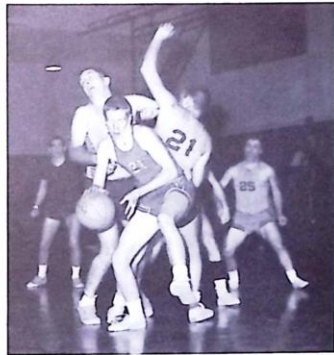

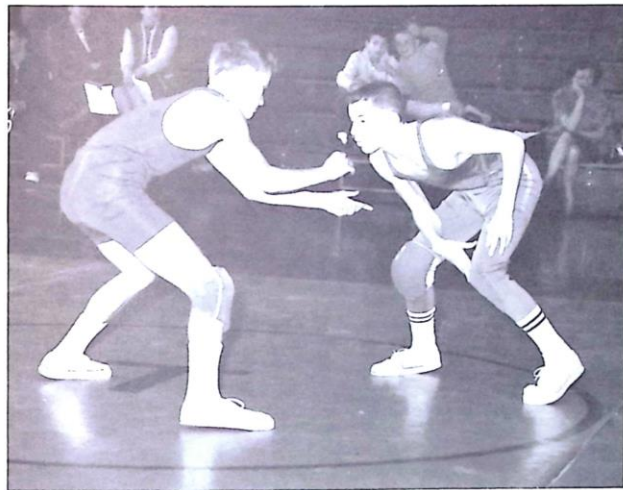

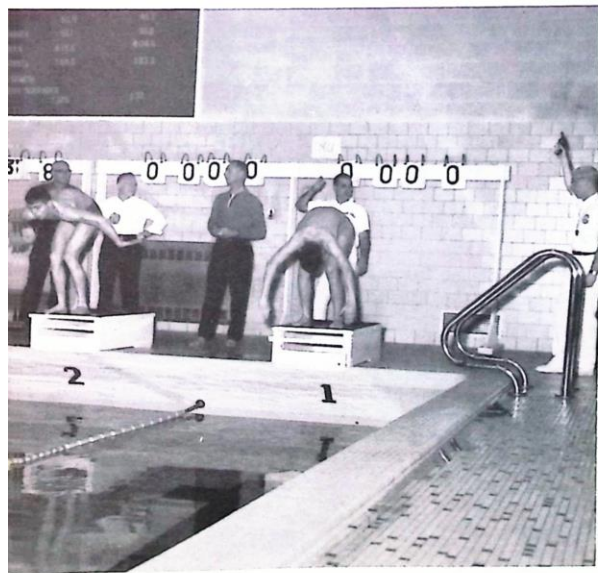

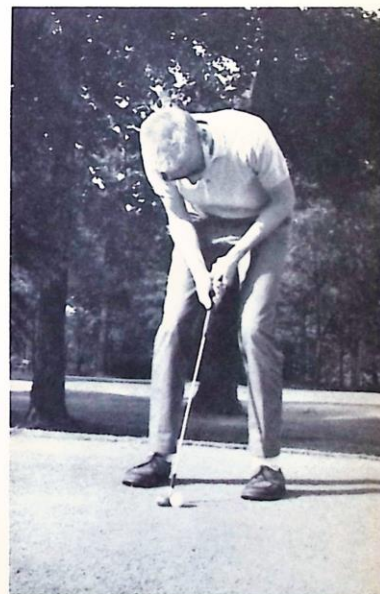

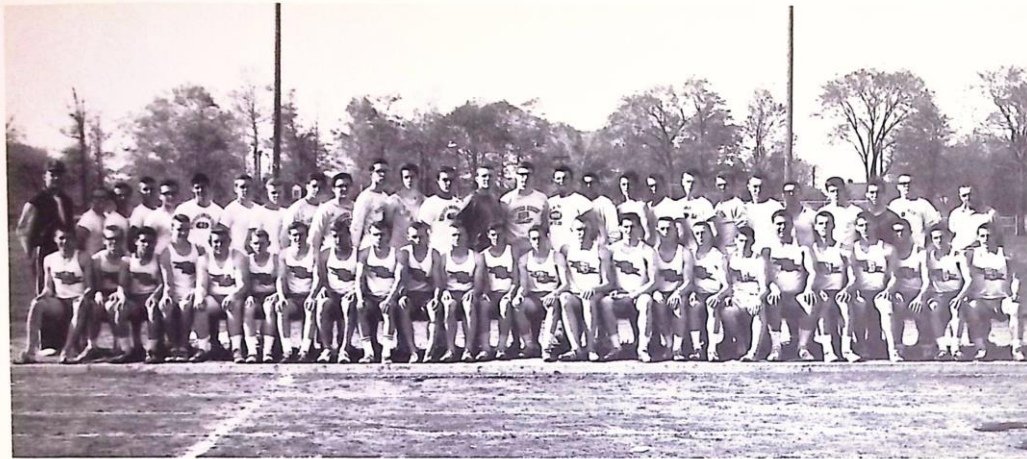

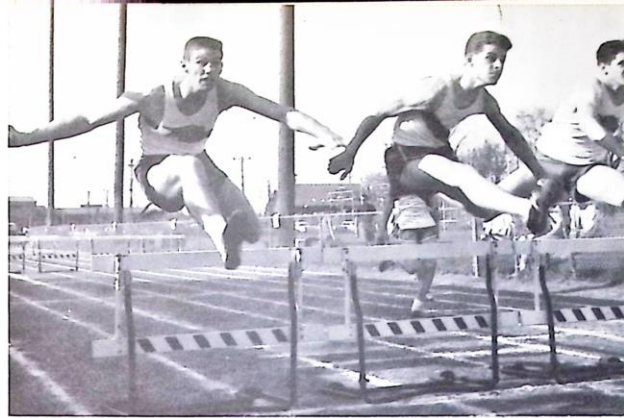

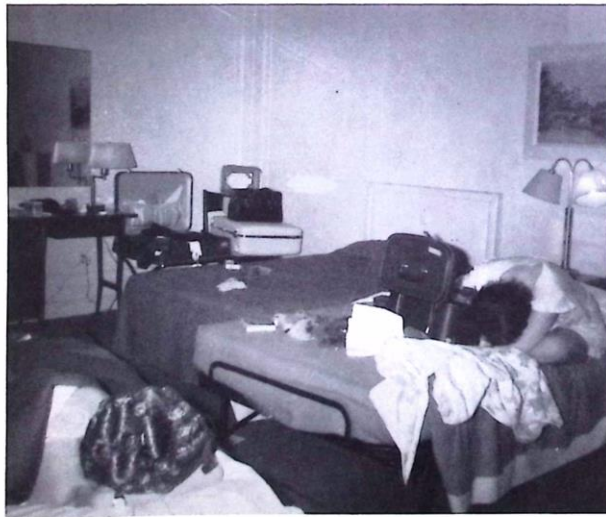

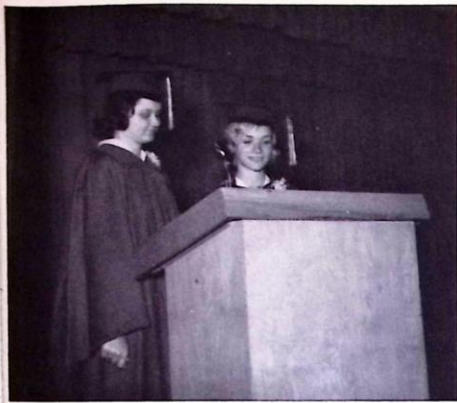

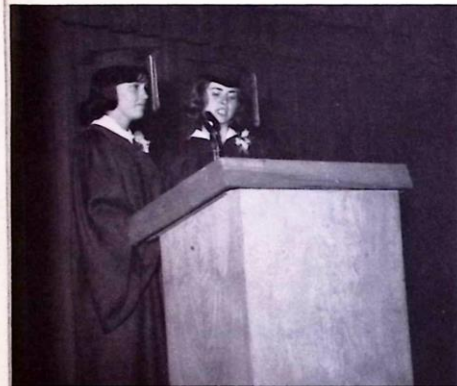

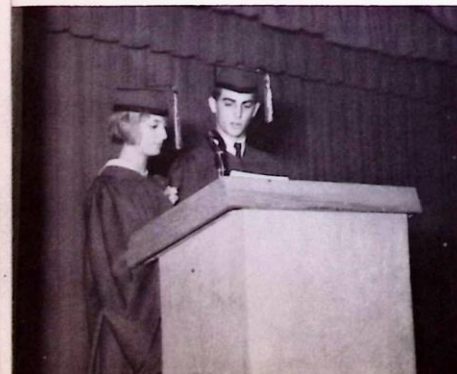

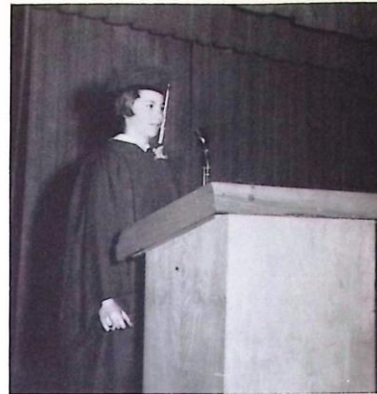

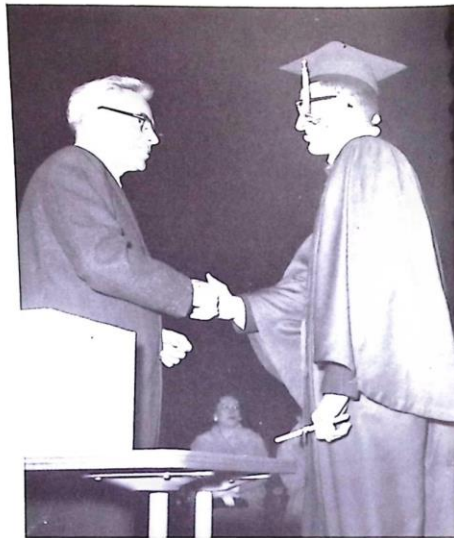

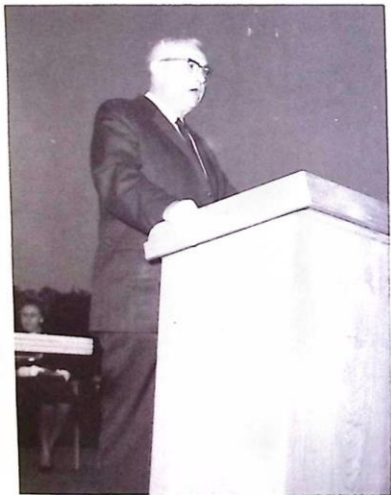
