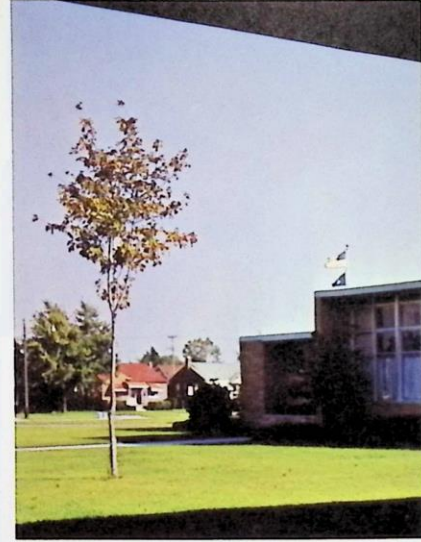


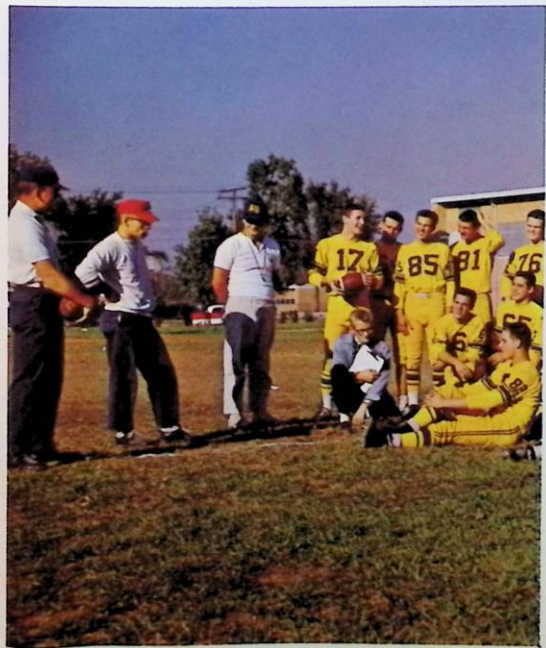
This spring not only the seniors are leaving Redford Union; Mr. Ward Estes, principal since 1953, is retiring after seventeen years of service in the Redford Union Schools.

Mr. Estes, who has a Bachelor's degree from Michigan State and a Master's from the University of Michigan, came to Redford Union in 1935 as a teacher and football coach. He was principal in June, 1940, when he was recalled for service in World War II.

During his five years of active service, he held many administrative posts, closing his career as an intelligence officer with the rank of Major. When he retired from the reserves in 1960, he held the rank of Lt. Colonel.

In 1953, he returned to R.U. as principal, a position he has held to the present. To honor his years of service and guidance, the 1965 BLUE and GOLD is dedicated as a lasting tribute to Mr. Estes.

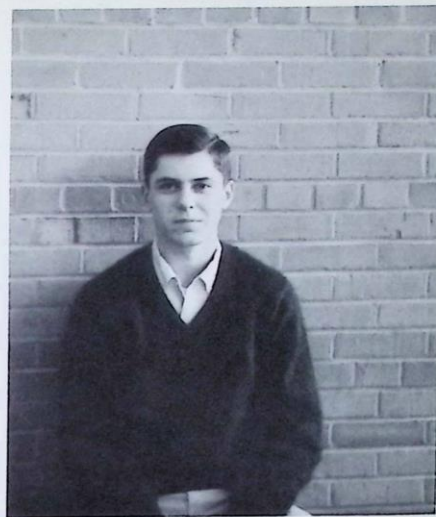
With the honoring of Seniors at Class Day, the Prom that night at Lovett Hall, and Commencement, the Panorama of school life was completed.

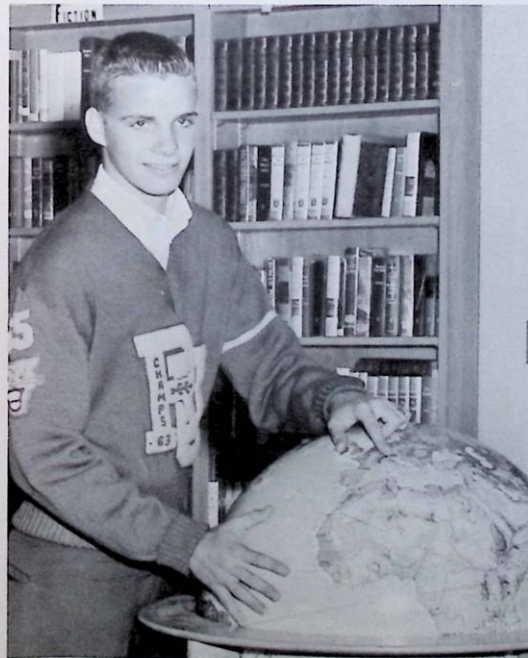

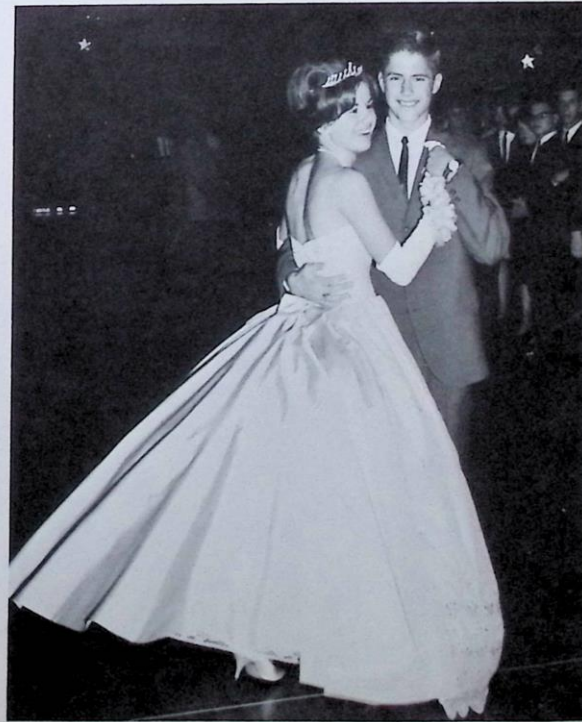

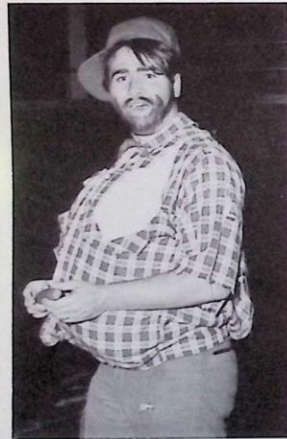

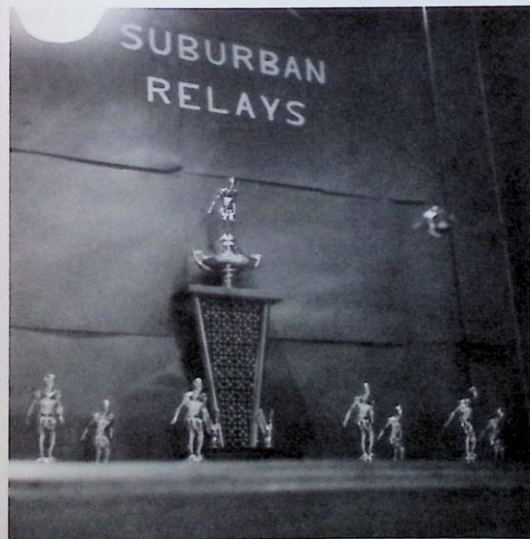

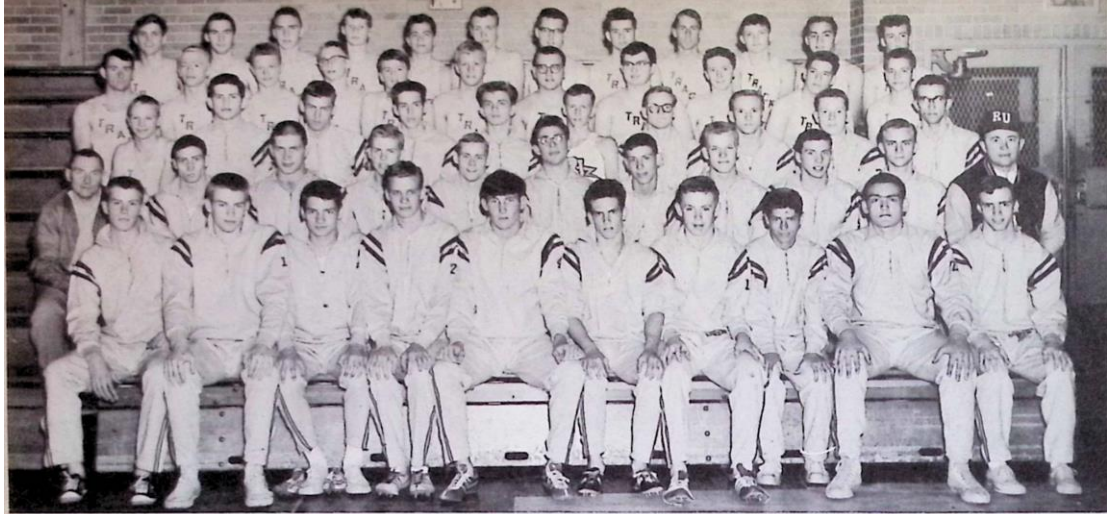

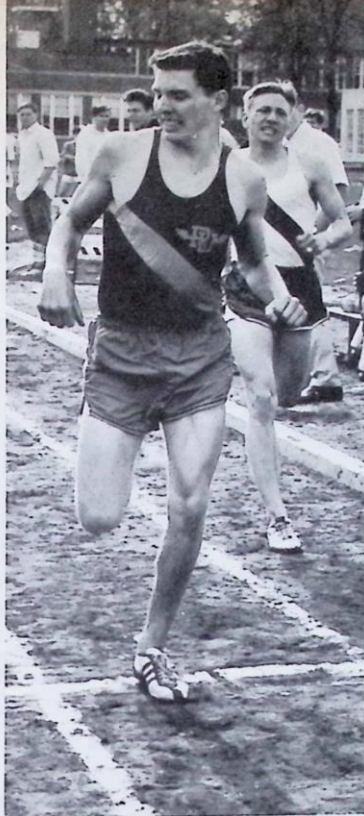

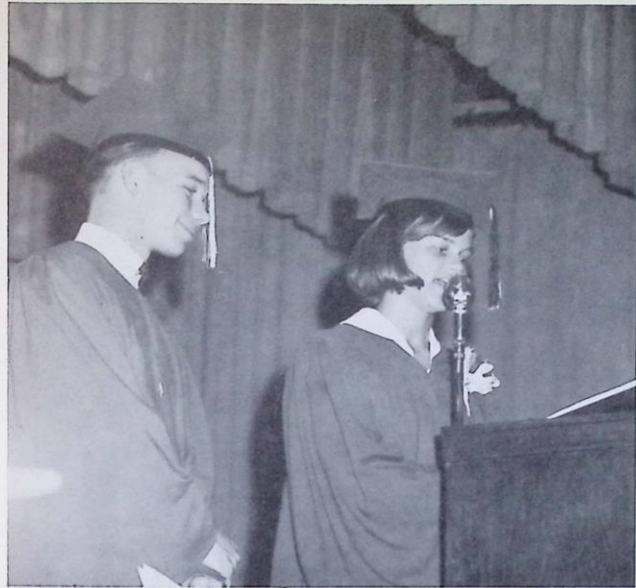
